



PARISH COUNCIL ANNUAL RETURN

Each year the Parish Council's annual return is audited by an auditor appointed by the Audit Commission. Any persons interested has a right to inspect the accounts and make copies of the annual return and all books, deeds contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating to the accounting statements (charges may apply).

For the year ending 31st March 2016 these documents will be available (at reasonable notice) by applications to the Parish Clerk from 30th June 2016 until 15th August 2016 by contacting the Clerk at Email: westonunderwoodpc@gmail.com

Local electors and their representatives also have the opportunity to question the auditor about the accounts and the right to make objections to the accounts or any item in them.

Written notice of an objection must first be given to the auditor and a copy sent to the Council. The auditor can be contacted at the address below for this purpose from the 15th August 2016 until the audit has been completed.

The audit is being conducted under the provisions of the Audit Commission Act 1998, the Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2011 and the Audit Commission's Code of Audit Practice.
